伍華書院三十五週年校慶暨新翼祝聖典禮 冠蓋雲集共賀新紀元



伍華書院自創校至今已踏進三十五週年,為慶盛事,本校於三月二日舉行三十五週年校慶暨新翼祝聖典禮。本校得蒙天主教香港教區主教胡振中樞機蒞臨主持感恩祭並任主禮嘉賓,參與共祭神父七位,包括:余尚實神父、康建璋神父、伍國寶神父、黃國昌神父、李志源神父、倪德文神父及范錦棠神父。與會嘉賓除了家長、校監及友校校長外,還包括教育署黃大仙分區教育署學校發展組、教育署建校組、建築處、優質教育基金的代表等等,場面熱鬧。

慶祝活動包括感恩祭及節目欣賞兩部份。伍國寶神父在講道中讚揚伍華書院是一所充滿生命力的學校。又謂多年來伍華書院培育了不少社會上的棟樑。而學校更是增值不少,最具體的便是新翼的落成。伍神父期望同學在學校的悉心栽培下,能將生命力不斷發揚。



節目表演由中、小學部的同學擔綱演出。小學部上午校的表演一伍華幼苗頌新聲,由歌詠團獻唱三首歌曲等下華 校的演出一樂韻妙舞賀伍華,由牧童團香作演出;中學部則由中樂 團表演中樂名曲〈將軍令〉,參與隊員共 強百, 氣勢迫人。三項表演均極視聽之 娱, 深得在場嘉賓讚賞。整個禮儀於中午十二時左右結束, 各嘉賓均盡興而歸。











伍華書院童軍(九龍第一百四十旅)一九六六年成立至今踏進三十五週年。為慶盛事,本旅特於二零零一年二月十七日下午四時假伍華書院禮堂舉行三十五週年旅慶。當日之主禮嘉賓有香港童軍總會助理香港總監(訓練)康寶森先生、香港童軍九龍城區區務委員會主席王錦輝先生、伍華書院李志源神父、陳錦添校長、曾秀校長、李淑儀校長以及首任旅長遺孀陳建磐夫人等,參與人數近四百,當中還有不少闊別童軍三十多年的舊生聚首一堂,場面既熱鬧又溫馨。

康總監在致詞時指出一個童軍旅團能屹立三十 五年委實不易,而且辦得有聲有色更是難能可貴。 他又指出童軍運動與學校教育之基本分別,童軍運 動在的目的於鼓勵青少年人勇於承擔和參與社會服 務的精神,從而建立健康、愉快的人生,而非要求 青年人事事追求完滿。


















伍華書院中學部第二十五屆周年陸運會 健兒盡顯體育潛能

1. 學生輔導工作坊



輔導組為有興趣同學提供小組輔導,


讓同學更能 認識自己,結交朋友及培養思考領導能力。







A PLASER

In May, some of our S1 boys volunteered for a new speech recognition project known as PLASER. This new project was run by our school in conjunction with the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology as part of the QEF (Quality Education Fund) project.

The aim of PLASER is to improve students' pronunciation in English through the use of speech recognition software. Five schools, including Ng Wah, have been invited to make use of this new technology. One of the Assistant Professors responsible for the programme at the university, Dr. Brian Mak, is a Ng Wah old boy. The project is being held as an extra-curricular activity with the help of



Mr. Chan Fai Hung and Mr. Thomas. The students use the computers in the MMLC (Multi-Media Language Center) to listen to native English speakers pronouncing words on the computer. They must then repeat the sounds they hear. With the help of computer technology, students can find out how accurately they are saying the sounds. After all the sessions have been completed, they will take another assessment test to find out if their level

of English pronunciation accuracy has improved or not.

As this is a pilot scheme which is being funded by the Education Department, the results are being monitored closely. So far, most students seem to have enjoyed using the system, and, after a few initial minor hiccups, the scheme is now running very smoothly. If the scheme is found to be successful, it will be extended in the coming year. We will keep you posted on developments in coming issues.





























S1 and S2 English Camps



This year, our NET teacher, Mr. Farrell, accompanied groups of 30 S1 and S2 students on two English day camps to Sai Kung, where they met students and NET teachers from three other schools. During the weeks before the two sessions, Mr. Farrell worked hard with other NET teachers to arrange a range of short activities for the students to join, including singing English songs,

solving riddles, activity quizzes and word games. Once all the preparations were completed,

students were invited to join the camps. They visited different 'activity centres' where the NET teachers had made all their preparations. The whole purpose of the sessions was to let students learn English in an enjoyable way and to have a learning experience outside the classroom. Mr. Farrell hopes that in the coming school year even more of these camps will be held so that students can realize that English learning can actually be a very enjoyable experience.



Speech Festival Certificates



The certificates for the English Speech Festival recently arrived at our school. Over a hundred of our students entered the competition, and the majority of them received proficiency certificates. Several students even managed to get over 90 marks in the speech festival, meaning that they received an honours certificate, and one of our

senior form students managed to reach the final and come first place overall despite competition from top schools all over the

territory. Next year, Mr. Wai promises to extend the programme to more classes and students. Congratulations to all involved!



English Courses to Continue



During Christmas and Easter, a number of English courses were held for students. These courses were held by the British Council and were offered to Ng Wah students at special promotional fees. The aims of the courses were to let students have more confidence in communicating with others in English, and to have more contact with native-English speaking teachers who are professionally qualified. Response from parents was good, especially in lower forms. At Christmas, several courses were held for S3 and S4 students and at Easter, courses were held for eight classes

of S1 to S4 students.

During the summer, 8 more courses will be run for S2 and S3 students. These courses will be run by Park Language Group, which has been established in Hong Kong since 1995 and is registered with the Education Department. Staff are experienced native-English language teachers and trainers are instructed to use an active classroom approach. Students will be encouraged to take part in language-focus activities and projects. As with previous courses, we have used funds from the Education Department to subsidize costs for parents.

As well as these courses for S2-3, there will also be courses for S4 students taught by our own teachers in the first two weeks of the summer holidays and an Intensive English Programme will be held for S6 students. All our English teachers will be volunteering their time during the summer holidays to teach these courses.



Paired Reading Scheme

This year's paired reading scheme proved to be a big success. S4 and S6 students volunteered their time to pair up with lower form students and help them to improve their reading, speaking and pronunciation. Participants were told that they must attend 80 per cent of sessions to be awarded a certificate, and only one student failed to attend the required number of sessions. As a result, we plan to continue and extend the scheme in the coming year. We are extremely grateful to the English Club for helping to organize this activity.

Activities of Catholic Society



Many are under the impression that religion must bore them. The fact is that it is not boring at all. Having the role of arousing students' attention to Catholicism, the Catholic Society has made a strenuous effort to show how meaningful religion is.

The members of this academic year totalled 78. We have organized a wide variety of activities for not just the members but all the students. These activities include members' gatherings, prayer meetings, Passover Meals and Students' Retreats as well as a joint

school camp.

By playing games, the members have raised their awareness of what religion is. The prayer meetings are aimed at offering students the time and the opportunity to relax and relieve pressure. They are regularly held in the chapel during lunch hour.

Students' Retreat is a traditional function held every March. The venue is Cheung Chau and the duration is two days. During this function, students are classified into different groups and play a handful of games. But there is more to it than that. There is an opportunity to have a self-examination and strengthen their faith in God.


