# 河南省鄭州及開封歷史文化 與黃河體驗之旅



本校師生共四十四人於六月二十二日至二十六日到達河南省鄭州及開封進行歷史文化考察，藉以了解鄭州、洛陽及開封的歷史文化、風土人情，並參觀黃河的水利工程，感受地質公園的魅力，以及與當地的大學生互相交流，彼此學習。

參加此次交流團的主要是中四及中五級的學生。在五日四夜的旅程中，他們分別參觀了黃河遊覽區、清明上河園、雲台山地質國家公園、龍門石窟、小浪底樞紐工程等代表河南特色的景區。短短五天的行程，使學生對河南源遠流長的歷史文化讚歎不已！

考察團首天大部份時間在高鐵旅程中渡過，由深圳南站出發，列車穿州過省，走過二千公里，終於在七個小時後抵達鄭州。雖然路途遙望，車程漫長，但仍不減學生的熱情，他們以萬分期待之心情感受這古都的氣息。抵步後，在導遊帶領下，學生爭取時間，率先參觀了黃河博物館，對這條孕育中華民族的母親之河有了基礎的認識，離開博物館後，學生立即前往花園口黃河觀賞區，親身感受黃河的壯觀景觀，第一天的旅程便在黃昏美景中結束。

次日，同學前往開封體驗清明上河園的民俗風情。清明上河園是參照我國著名的畫作－《清明上河圖》而建成，把栩栩如生的畫中景觀化為實景並展現在學生面前。除了園中的一草一木一石一瓦都參照原作外，園中的表演環節也把古時的民俗風情原貌真實地表現出來，連園中的工作人員也以古裝打扮，其敬業樂業的態度，令置身園中的學生親身領略到古代風情，也令師生一行樂上半天。

第三天，學生前往雲臺山國家地質公園考察，感受山水之情，欣賞磅礴山勢。雲臺山國家地質公園是著名的沉積岩地質考察地，與美國大峽谷國家公園締結為姊妹公園，並經常互相交流保育、管理的資訊，足見其前往地位。當天，師生一行浩浩蕩蕩地走到山腳，可惜美中不足，天公不造美，下起綿綿細雨，但亦無損學生的登山雄志，紛紛穿上雨衣，昂然踏上山路，前往感受大自然的鬼斧神工。在導賞員的帶領下，學生攀登至山腰，觀賞著名的雲台天瀑，欣賞高掛在峭壁的大型瀑布傾瀉而下，水瀑撞擊岩石及水塘，奏出大自然的優美樂章，學生也對此奇景嘖嘖稱奇。午飯後，學生可以選擇遊覽紅石峽、潭瀑峽，亦有學生跟隨老師，挑戰超過一千米高的主峰茱萸峰，登高懷古，在高峰欣賞唐代大詩人王維曾在此寫下的千古名句：「遙知兄弟登高處，遍插茱萸少一人。」師生皆盡興而歸。

第四天，學生前往我國著名的古都－洛陽，遊覽中國三大石窟之一的龍門石窟，考察唐宋的佛教雕刻藝術。龍門石窟已被納入世界文化遺產之一，石窟座落伊河兩旁，連綿數公里，十分壯觀。學生需要在石級中不斷爬上爬落，觀賞每尊神態各異的佛像，雖然艱辛，但能近距離欣賞古代的偉大藝術品，同學們都沒有怨言。龍門石窟中最大、最著名的石窟是奉先寺，寺內的三尊巨大佛像是武則天下令開鑿的，代表了唐代佛教雕刻藝術的巔峰。由於最近的一輯電視劇－《武則天》大受香港觀眾歡迎的關係，學生對此石窟有濃厚的興趣，不但細心閱讀石窟的介紹及歷史，更主動請教老師及導賞員，學習氣氛濃厚。事後更有學生表示，對這中國唯一女皇帝有了正面的看法，回到香港要到圖書館研究其事蹟云云。「讀萬卷書不如行萬里路」，學生能在旅途中激發學習興趣，主動學習，令同行的老師大感欣慰。下午，學生參觀新型農村，漂亮的建築，乾淨寬敞的房屋令學生對農村落後簡陋的形象大大改觀，了解到中國農村的巨大轉變。最後，學生前往小浪底水庫，學習了疏治黃河的理念和水利科學的知識，領略了中華民族治理黃河的成就。

最後一天，學生在踏上歸途前，前往河南財經及政治大學與當地的本科學生展開面對面的學習和交流，分享學習經歷，暢談夢想，大家都留下了美好的印象。

河南的歷史文化和黃河體驗之旅給學生上了生動又真實的一課，這是在書本上學習不到的，短短五天的旅程中，學生親身體驗黃河歷史文化，收穫豐富，受益匪淺。





# 全港通識理財問答比賽 本校獲得「最踴躍參與獎」

由《信報通識》、香港教育城、香港教育局及金融管理局合辦「全港通識理財問答比賽」頒獎典禮於2015年7月11日舉行。本校榮獲是次比賽的「最踴躍參與獎」。這次比賽是首次融合理財與通識的概念，全港超過140間學校、6000人次參加，同學須在網上於限時內回答60條題目。比賽內容涉及青少年個人理財及通識範疇，目的旨在強化學生的理財概念，建立正確金錢價值觀，學習規劃未來。例如：學生學習財務管理技巧，了解身為消費者及投資者的責任，為實踐夢想而累積財富。
