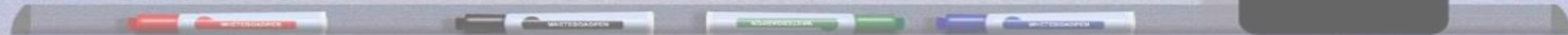
Morning
