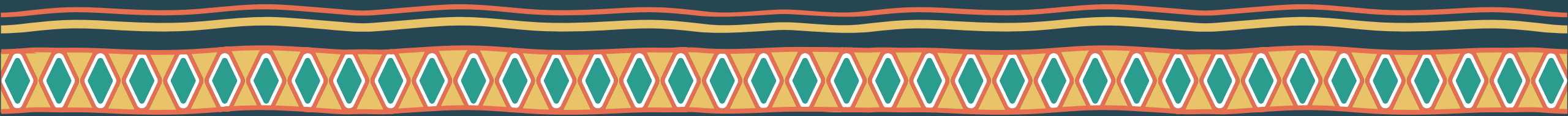
He was a famous leader in the Soviet Union and one of the important people of the 20th century. He got power in the 1920s and became the General Secretary of the Communist Party in 1924.

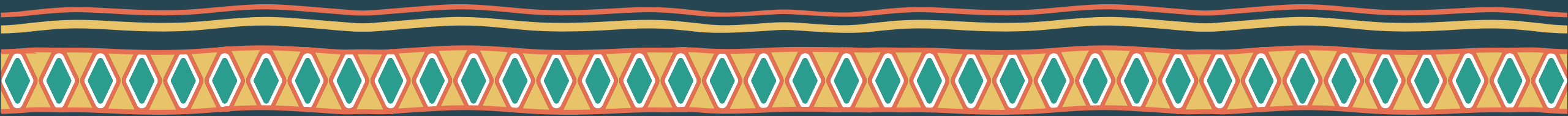

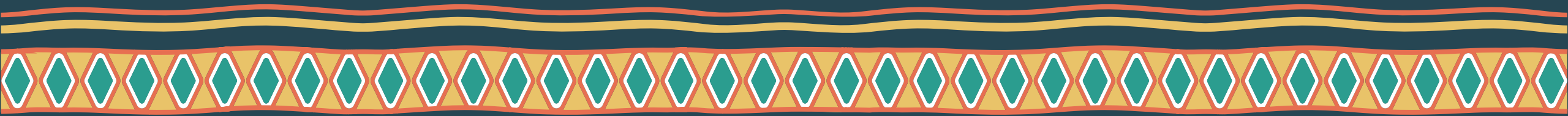
The Soviet Union **launched** successful attacks, like the Battle of Stalingrad, which changed the course of the war and led to the **defeat** of Nazi Germany.



However, Stalin's rule also caused much **suffering**, with policies such as collective farming which resulted in **famine**, mass executions and the **imprisonment** of millions in labour camps.



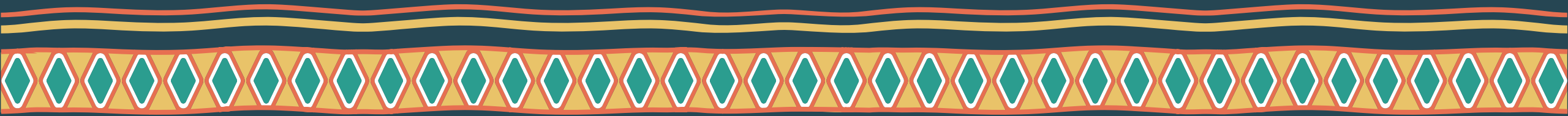
Joseph Stalin's life was **controversial**. He made important progress for the Soviet Union and defeated the fascist Nazis, but his rule also caused many negative effects.
