Is bullying a serious problem in Hong Kong schools?

Do you know what bullying is? Bullying refers to the fact that under the circumstances of strong and weak disparities, the weak side is continuously injured physically or psychologically by the strong side.

Of the 5000 Hong Kong students interviewed, 32.3% had been bullied in the past month, including being attacked, excluded, intimidated and tricked but for many schools in Hong Kong, bullying on campus is often regarded as a "thin play".

When a school has a bullying incident, the school social workers first evaluate and then intervene, and provide psychological counselling to the victim. Then, the Discipline Team punish the bully appropriately.

Finally, bullying is certainly wrong so that school must join the process to reduce bullying at Hong Kong schools.
